

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTION: ASEAN + 1 Scholarship

- **What if I don't have an IELTS/TOEFL result yet? What other proof of English proficiency can I use?**
 - Worry not, because you can submit a letter from your school/institution or an unofficial test results of any test. However, you will still be required to submit your official IELTS/TOEFL result at a later stage.
- **What health certificate do I need? Does it have to be from a specific hospital?**
 - A health certificate is a letter from any hospital to state that you are in good health. Please provide the health certificate in english.
- **What is the link to the online application form?**
 - This the the online application link: <http://um.ugm.ac.id/>
- **Can I apply without a passport?**
 - Yes, you can submit a different identification of some form but please make sure that english translation is provided.
- **Will I still have to go to Yogyakarta even if the 1st semester will be online?**
 - No, you will only be required to come to Yogyakarta when classes have been decided to be conducted in-person
- **I don't have my graduation certificate yet; can I still apply?**
 - Yes, you can still apply with a letter from your institution stating that you will graduate. An official graduation certificate will still be required to be submitted later on.
- **How long is the undergraduate program in FISIPOL UGM?**
 - It is 3.5-4 years long, consisting: 6 semesters (3 years) of theory & classes, and 1-2 semester (1 year) for thesis writing.
- **What majors are offered with the scholarship?**
 - There are 3 majors: International Relations (IR), Public Policy and Management (PPM), and Communication Science.
- **How many majors can I apply to with the scholarship?**
 - You can apply up to 2 majors from the 3 offered with the scholarship.
- **Will the classes be conducted in English or Bahasa Indonesia?**
 - Fully in English, as you will enroll in the International Undergraduate Program.
- **Do I need to know Bahasa Indonesia in time of my application?**
 - No, but you can learn it here in UGM.

- **When will I need to be in Yogyakarta?**
 - In the midst of this pandemic, we cannot say for certain yet. But when it has been decided that classes will resume as normal, we will inform the selected applicants of the further process.

- **Do I need to pay the registration fee?**
 - No, but make sure to pick the FISIPOL ASEAN+1 Scholarship Program in your online application.

- **Is the Student VISA fee covered by the scholarship?**
 - As of now, no, a fee of USD 150 is required to be paid for the student Visa by the applicant.
